What is guest lecturing?

An ASU faculty is invited to give a series (2, 3 or 4), 60-minute, virtual lectures, for a specific partner school and a specific course. [The form for requesting](#) guest lecturing for Aug-Dec 2025 is currently open. Diego works with Lois to fulfill the requests and find suitable faculty.

Course Webinars

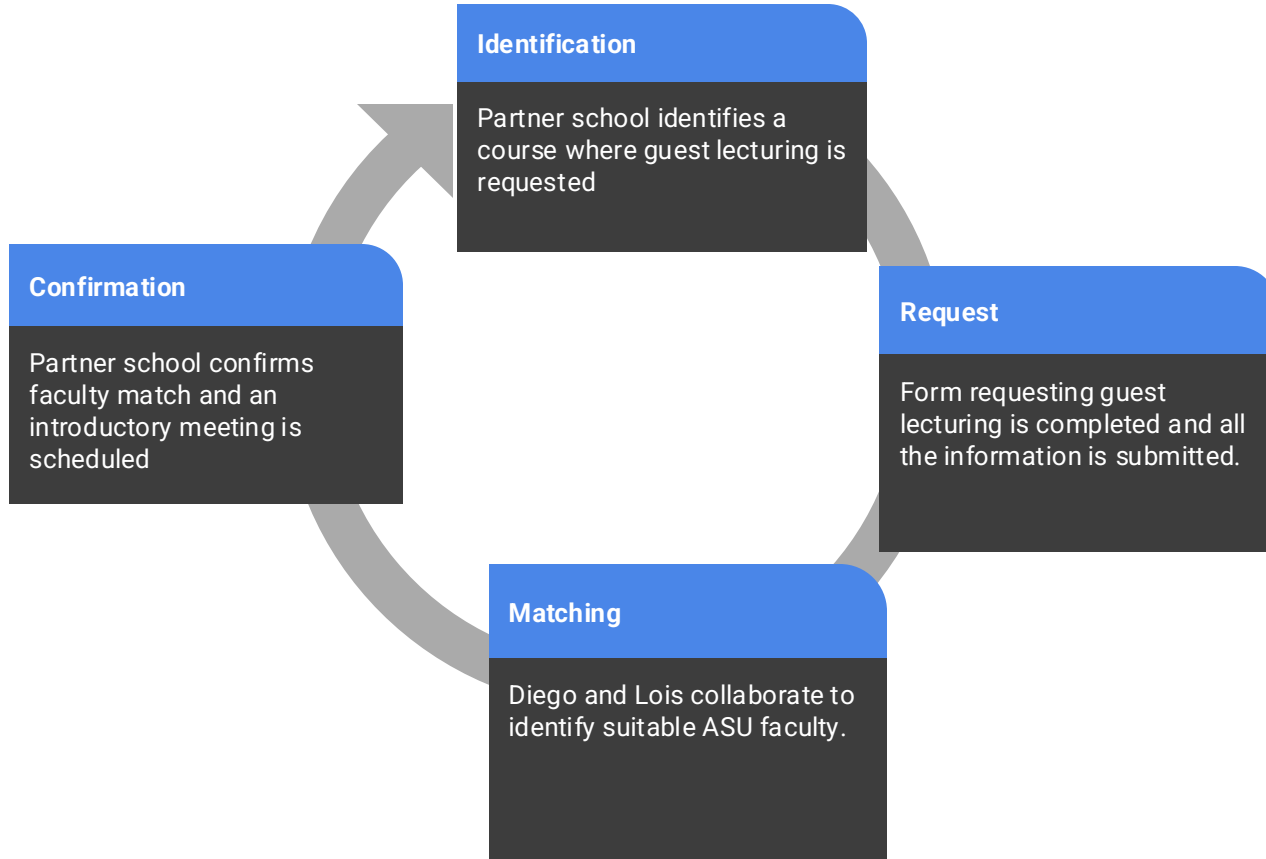
Webinars are single, 60-minute lectures provided by an ASU faculty. They are similar to a keynote speaker at a conference, only for students in a specific course.

Sometimes finding ASU faculty to provide several lectures in a complex course is too difficult. Single course webinars are a good alternative in this situation.

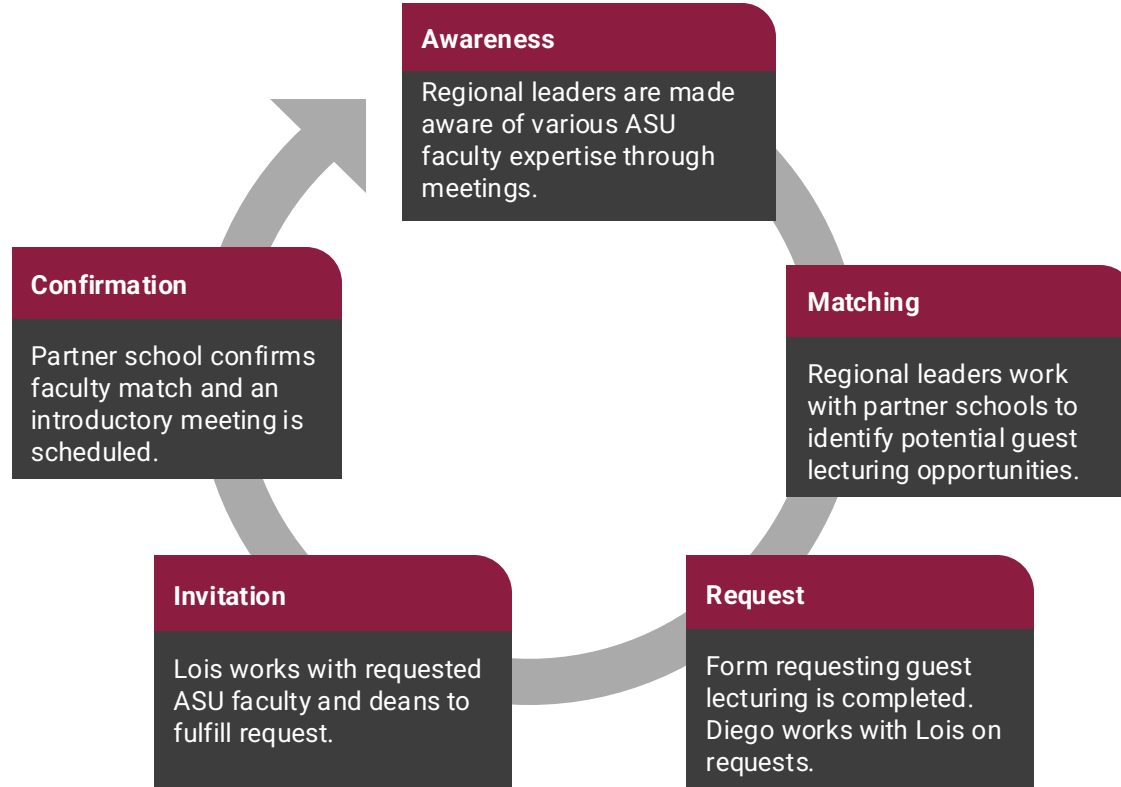
Cost of lectures or webinar for Fall 2025 and Spring 2026
