1. THE INSTITUTION WILL IDENTIFY THE STAFF AND FACULTY THEY WANT TO GRANT ACCESS TO THE CONTENT REPOSITORY.

2. THE INSTITUTION WILL SHARE THE SELF-ENROLL LINK BELOW WITH THE SELECTED FACULTY AND STAFF:

3. TO RECEIVE ACCESS TO THE CONTENT REPOSITORY, YOU MUST COMPLETE AND PASS THE ASU-CINTANA CONTENT REPOSITORY BEST PRACTICES AND TRAINING COURSE. YOU SHOULD FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW TO LOGIN.

- Enter your institutional email address
- Click on "I am a new user"
- Enter your full name
- Click on the checkbox "I agree to the Acceptable Use Policy"
- Click on the reCAPTCHA box
- Click on the button "Enroll in Course"

NOTE: YOU MUST FILL OUT THE ASURITE ID FORM AVAILABLE AT THE END OF THE COURSE TO RECEIVE YOUR ASURITE ID ACTIVATION EMAIL.

4. ONCE YOU HAVE PASSED THE COURSE, YOU WILL RECEIVE TWO EMAILS: A) A DIGITAL CERTIFICATE IN 10 BUSINESS DAYS; AND B) ASURITE ID ACTIVATION IN UP TO 5 BUSINESS DAYS.

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5. YOU WILL RECEIVE THE EMAIL WITH A LINK TO ACTIVATE YOUR ASURITE ID FROM ASU. AS SOON AS YOU RECEIVE THE ACTIVATION EMAIL, MAKE SURE YOU COMPLETE THE ACTIVATION RIGHT AWAY AS THE LINK WILL ONLY LAST FOR 48 HOURS. AFTER LINK EXPIRES, WE WOULD NEED TO RESTART THE PROCESS.

About the ASURITE User ID

An Arizona State University Rational Information Technology Environment (ASURITE) is the primary login for ASU computing services. Every person at ASU is assigned an ASURITE UserID. This UserID is unique and is yours to use as long as you are associated with ASU, and you follow the [appropriate policies and guidelines](#).

The ASURITE UserID is used to access various services at ASU. Your eligibility for services will depend on your affiliation with ASU.

To activate your ASURITE User ID, please click on the link provided in the ASURITE ID Activation email.

You will be asked to provide your email, date of birth and the code provided in the email. After activation you will be taken to the MyASU page. You will be able to see your ASURITE ID and ASU email by clicking on the arrow next to your name on the top right corner of the page. Click on "View Profile" to see all of your profile information.

6. AFTER ACTIVATING THE ASURITE ID YOU WILL BE ABLE TO LOGIN TO THE CONTENT REPOSITORY. PLEASE FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

- To avoid any conflicts, logout of your Gmail account (if you have one), clear cache and cookies
- Close all open tabs
- Open a new browser window and access: <https://repository.poweredby.asu.edu>
- The ASU Sign In page should appear (see image below)
- Enter your ASURITE User ID and Password

7. BEFORE YOU ARE DIRECTED TO THE CONTENT REPOSITORY PAGE, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE ONE ADDITIONAL STEP. YOU WILL NEED TO CHOOSE A SECONDARY AUTHENTICATION METHOD.

We recommend you download and install the DUO Mobile App – see steps below:

Install the Duo Mobile App: Using Smartphone or Tablet and the Duo Mobile App

1. This option allows you to use the "push" notification, generate passcodes, and (if using a smart phone) use text messages or calls to authenticate. When using passcodes, you can do so without a wifi or cell phone connection. This is the most reliable and flexible option.
 - Download and install Duo Mobile app on your smartphone or tablet prior to enrollment.
 - In the app store on your mobile device, search for "Duo Mobile".
 - Download and install the Duo Mobile app. For information on how to download and install apps, see your mobile device's documentation.
2. Choose the "Mobile phone" option.
3. The software will help you complete the process. More information is available in DUO's [Enrollment guide](#).
4. When complete, you will see "Device successfully added!". You may either click the "Continue to login" button or leave the page.
5. You can close the Duo app on your device it is ready for use.

2. WHAT ARE STUDENTS REACHED?

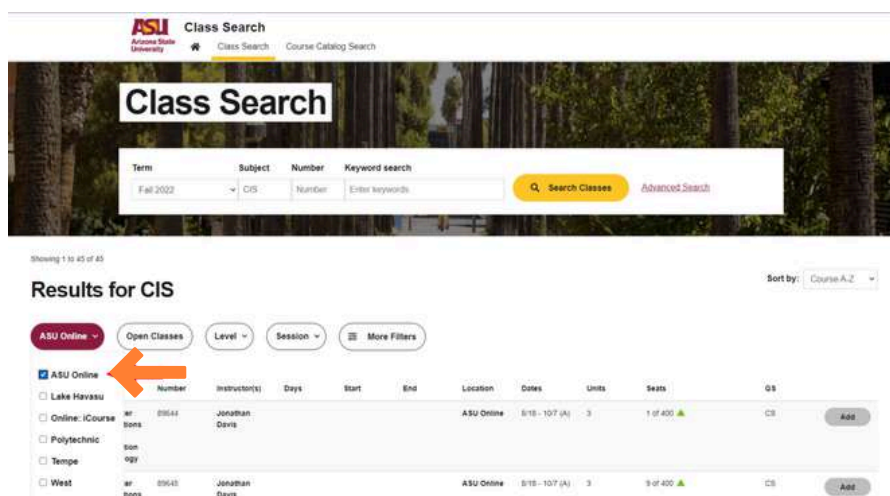

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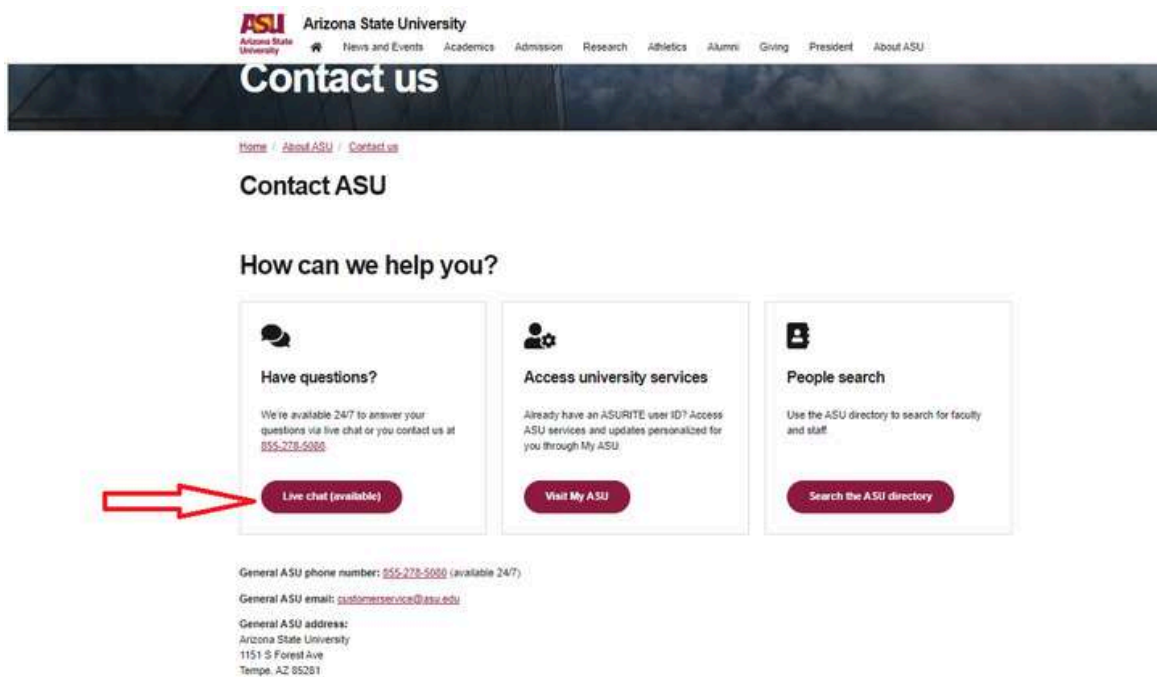
