

Through participation in this program, participants will:

- Be able to master modern communicative techniques for engaging students in multiple English language learning environments.
- Recognize, identify, and use language acquisition theories and principles to develop sound lesson plans.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Foundational Principles

Through a series of engaging metaphors and stories, learners will identify, summarize, and evaluate 7 basic language learning paradigms. Learners will be presented information on such foundational principles as motivation, risk taking, and balancing the teacher profession. (Key words: 80/20, sticky, MUD—memorable/usable/durable, scaffolding, warm language)

Theories of Second Language Acquisition

In this course, learners are introduced to second or foreign language theories and practices for teaching and assessing listening, speaking, and pronunciation. Learners go back in time to experience teachers throughout history.

(Focus on the communicative approach).

Lesson Design and Assessment

Learners will be introduced to designing lesson plans based on principles and knowledge of learning objectives, assessment plans, methods, materials, and learning activities. Learners will find and prepare appropriate teaching materials through careful analysis, adaptation and creation of professional resources.

(Lesson planning taught using the communicative approach with students using the language 80% of the time while teachers "teach" 20%)

Second Language Reading, Writing, and Grammar

Learners will be presented information on reading and writing courses, and the integration of grammar instruction within those courses. The course will take learners through a series of fairy tales and fables to examine basic reading and writing strategies.

Second Language Listening, Speaking, and Pronunciation

Learners are introduced to the aspects of listening and speaking that are challenging for students and teachers. The course then discusses basic strategies to ease the acquisition and instruction of listening and speaking.

Technology Enriched Teaching

This course focuses on the key concepts learners need in order to effectively integrate technology into their teaching, without overshadowing language learning. Learners will discover current and future trends in educational technology, along with strategies for implementing these trends in the classroom.

Capstones 1 and 2: Online Practicum

In the capstone projects, learners will demonstrate their teaching skills. Learners will build on their assignments from the previous courses to deliver lesson plans, observe teachers, and create a professional teaching portfolio.

Capstone Projects

Capstone 1
